Operation Flamingo:

Flocked/Flock = When a massive flock of wild flamingos migrates to yours or someone else's front yard. Each designated group of students will be assigned a certain week and a "flock of flamingos" to participate in the fundraiser so everyone has a turn to "flock". They will travel to the house of each person chosen to get "flocked" and unashamedly "flock" their yard. Here are the rules.

1. **Call or text Ben Burklow (336) 602-0776 and ask that the students come remove the flamingos**, and that you will pay \$____, in which you will then decide how much you are going to donate. We ask that you donate anywhere between \$15-\$80 (or more if you feel so inclined).
2. **If you don't want your yard "Flocked" then you can purchase insurance for your home** with a one-time donation of at least \$15 (or more if you feel so inclined). See a student or Ben Burklow about purchasing your "insurance". **Please note this is an annual "policy" and must be renewed every year.**
3. **Each person who is "Flocked" gets to choose the next victim...**I mean person that the students will "visit" next.
4. **This year we will be offering extra incentives for donations during this time.** If you reach a minimum of \$20 you will receive one of our flamingo "flocking" stickers. If you reach a minimum of \$40 you will receive a flamingo "flocking" sticker AND t-shirt as well. Anyone who is flocked will automatically receive the t-shirt and sticker.

Note:

1. Set aside time to pray specifically for the student Ministry
2. Your yard will not be "flocked" more than once
3. Please do not remove Flamingos from your own yard
4. Please try and contact the day of to inquire about removal so we can reach as many homes as possible
