- 10. Regular service will begin at 11:00 am.**
- 11. Access to church will be limited to the 2nd floor only.**
- 12. Family Life Center will be closed.**
- 13. Elevator/Stairwells will be off limits.**
- 14. Water fountains will be turned off/Bottled water will be available.**
- 15. Restrooms will be open on 2nd floor only.**
- 16. Face masks will be available in the Vestibule/wear at your discretion.**
- 17. Hand sanitizer will be at entrance doors and at rest rooms.**
