Dear Beloved,

How well do you trust the Father? Oh, it's easy to say that you trust Him completely, but do you really? When you look at your bank account and you look at your stack of bills, can you say, without concern, "Father, there is not enough in the account to cover that stack, but I know you know," and walk away without another thought? When your child is away from the Lord and living a life that you know is hurting them, can you ask your Abba (Daddy) to watch over them and draw them back to Him and then stop worrying about that child?
